Our tour pick-up zones are noted on the map towards the back of the brochure. Most pick-up areas are included in your tour price. However, some areas attract a £25 or £50 surcharge, please ask at the time of booking (for online bookings the charge is added automatically)


Included in your tour price (unless stated) are all the excursions described in the brochure, but of course you don't have to partake, you're welcome to spend the day in the hotel or home resort, just let the driver or courier know. Please bear in mind that these excursions may have to be changed to another suitable alternative if necessary.

If you'd like to bring a mobility scooter or other aid on our tours and day trips, please let us know at the time of booking. This isn't usually a problem, we just need to know for space on our vehicles, particularly the feeder buses. Should you wish to hire a scooter, we recommend Yeovil Shop Mobility – 01935 420889. They will arrange delivery to and from our depot, leaving you with one less thing to worry about. We can then safely load the scooter onto the coach prior to departure.

We would advise you that single rooms for our tours are limited and if you require a single room, then you need to book very early. We can sometimes obtain additional single rooms, but this will have an increased supplement. Please also remember that seats are allocated on a first come, first served basis and if you have a preferred seat you are advised not to delay your booking.

As always, Personal Travel Insurance is not included in the price. We have Passenger Protection Insurance in place should something happen to us as a company. We, therefore, advise you to obtain your own insurance to protect you and your possessions.







MONDAY 6TH MAY - DAY 2

We begin our day at Standen House & Garden in Sussex. The house is one of the finest examples of Arts and Crafts workmanship, with Morris & Co. interiors whilst the hillside garden offers year-round highlights. In the afternoon we embark on a train journey from Sheffield Park to East Grinstead on the Bluebell Railway, the UK's first preserved standard gauge passenger railway. Whilst steaming through the pretty Sussex countryside, we tuck into a tasty cream tea and admire the views.



TUESDAY 7TH MAY - DAY 3



Today we visit the romantic, double-moated, 13th century Hever Castle. Well known as the childhood home of Anne Boleyn, we discover 700 years of history, exploring its panelled rooms, fine furniture, tapestries and antiques. Highlights include the Dining Hall, Long Gallery, Library, King Henry VIII's Bedchamber and Anne Boleyn's Bedroom. Outside we can wander 125 acres of award-winning gardens. See the Italian Garden, the giant topiary chess set & more than 5,000 rose bushes in the English Rose Garden.

WEDNESDAY 8TH MAY - DAY 4

Today begins with a visit to Emmetts Garden, a lovely hillside garden showcasing an amazing variety of flowering plants and exotic trees, with sweeping views of the Kent countryside. Take in the formal early 20th century Rose Garden, an extensive collection of trees and shrubs in the South Garden and the Rock Garden's varied alpine plant collection. This afternoon we make our way to Knole, a magnificent 600 year old estate covering around 1,000 acres in Sevenoaks, Kent, home to an historic country house and vast parkland. Explore the Showrooms, with textiles, paintings and a collection of Royal Stuart furniture to admire, and climb the spiral stairs of the Gatehouse Tower to take in the panoramic rooftop views. Outside we can stretch our legs in Kent's last medieval deer park, home to a herd of around 350 deer which famously roam the grounds.



THURSDAY 9TH MAY - DAY 5



Our last day together starts with a hearty breakfast to see us on our journey home to the West Country taking time to stop and enjoy the Cathedral City of Winchester.


